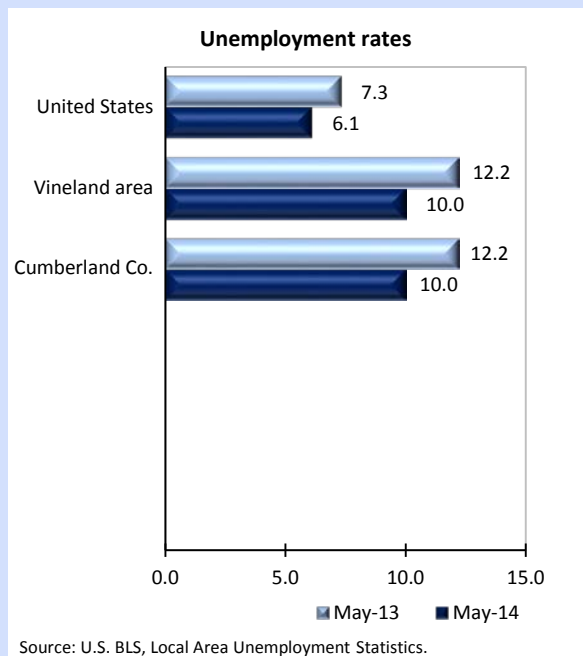


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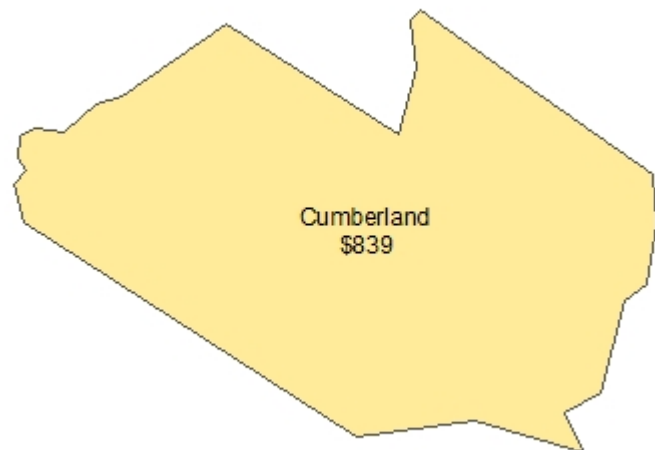

Unemployment rates for the Vineland area, selected area counties, and the nation

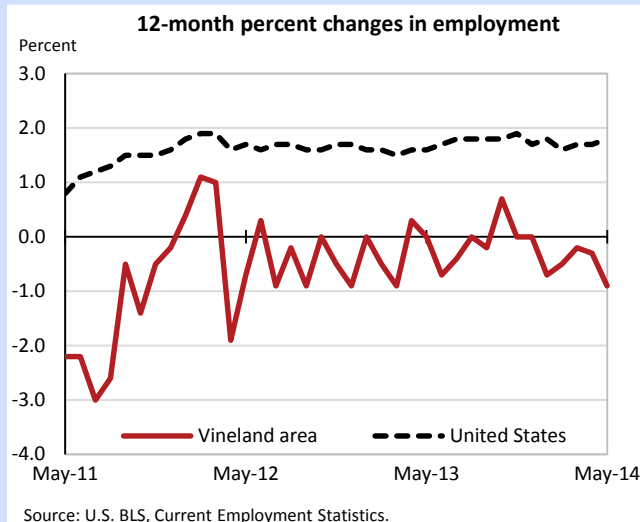


Average weekly wages for all industries by county

(U.S. = \$1,000; Area = \$839)



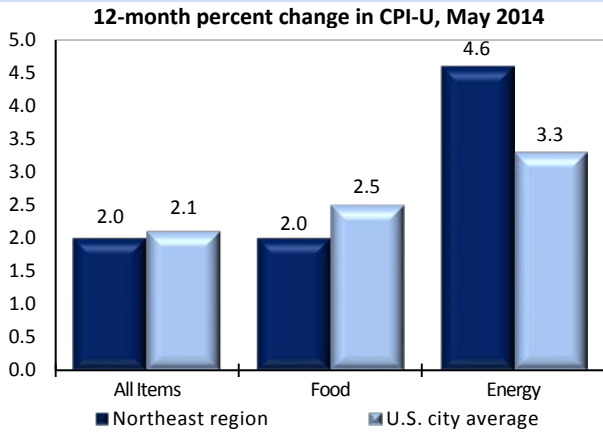

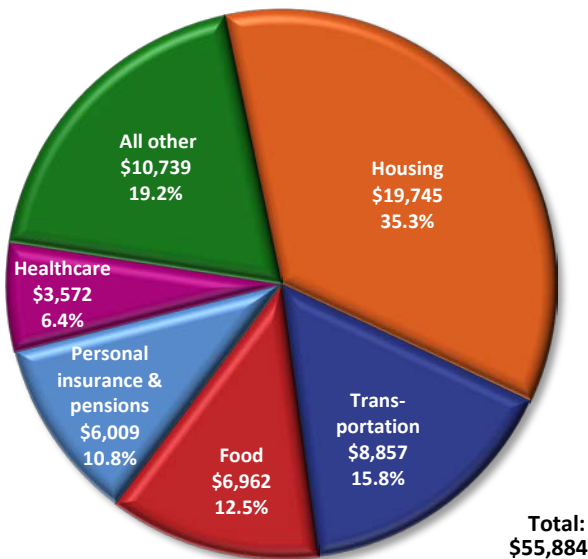
Over-the-year change in the prices paid by urban consumers for selected categories

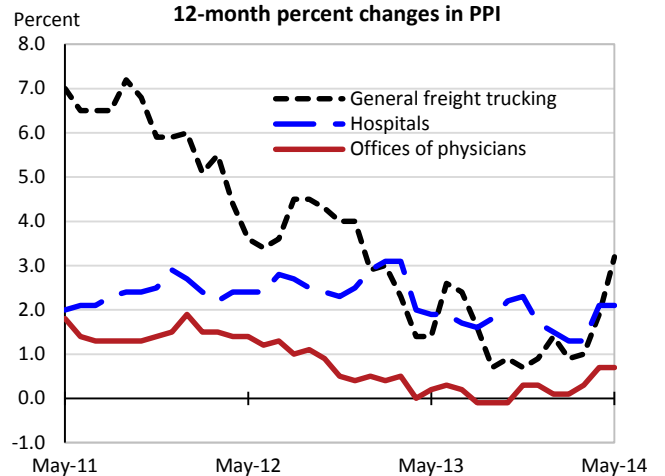
Average annual spending and percent distribution for selected categories

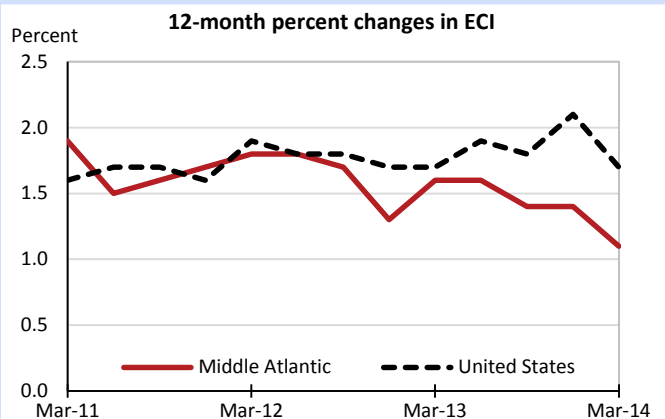
